KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK: Kaziranga National Park which hosts two-thirds of the world's great one-horned rhinoceroses.



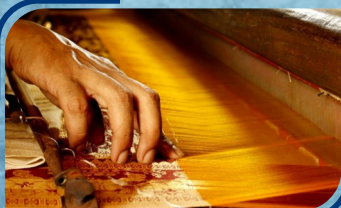
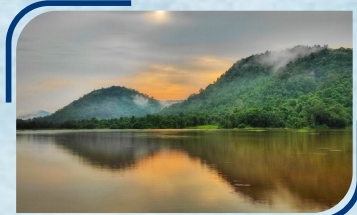
